

These accounts submitted to the AGM are for the year ending 30th September 2017 and shows that ESCUSA has made a deficit of £281.95.

As will be noted from the accounts the only income to the association is now from members and a raffle at last year's AGM. 28 members paid a membership for the current season and along with 5 honorary members, the association currently has 33 members.

The monies paid out are for courses from the previous season and even the majority of the miscellaneous outgoings are for the season 2015-16.

This is the third year in succession that a deficit has been recorded as other forms of revenue that ESCUSA used to take in are now taken on by Surrey ACO. It will obviously continue in this trend, as ESCUSA seems to become a redundant arm of Surrey ACO.
